May 21, 1922 - June 19, 2013

Anastasia "Ann" C. Osterried, 91, of Cowell Avenue, Oil City, formerly of Clarion, died June 19, 2013, at the UPMC Northwest Hospital in Seneca surrounded by her loving family, following a recent re-occurrence of lymphoma.

Ann was born May 21, 1922 in Snydersburg. She was the daughter of the late Francis C. Snyder and the late Elva M. Schmader Snyder. Ann was married on her birthday, May 21, 1947 to M. Edward Osterried at St. Joseph Catholic Church in Lucinda.
