Andrew D. Grolemond, 67, of Fryburg, died Thursday, March 1, 2012, at UPMC Northwest Hospital in Seneca.

He was born on May 27, 1944, in Snydersburg; he was the son of Sylvester “Nash” and Anna “Betty” Swartsfager Grolemond.

He was a 1962 graduate of St. Joseph’s School in Lucinda.

Mr. Grolemond was married on January 30, 1976 to the former Alice V. Baughman, and she survives.

A veteran, he served in the Army in the 82nd Airborne.

Mr. Grolemond worked at the Ochs Sawmill in Snydersburg. He had 40 years in the glass business, from Marienville to Parker to Atlanta, GA, and retired from Owens-Illinois Glass Plant in June 2010.

He was of the Catholic faith.
