Ann M. Magrini, 87, of 532 Wood Street, Clarion, died Monday, October 17, 2011, Serenity Hospice House in Shippenville.

Born June 15, 1924, in Clarion, she was the daughter of the late Amos A. and Folsom Dunkle Hartle.

She was married on September 18, 1947 to Gus Magrini Sr., who preceded her in death on February 2, 1992.

She worked as a secretary at the Clarion County Courthouse for seven years. She then worked for Weaver's Jewelers for 15 years, retiring in 1986.

Mrs. Magrini was a member of the Immaculate Conception Church in Clarion, where she was a member of the Immaculate Conception Guild and Funeral Team.
