Anna Jean (Uncapher) Foulks, age 93, of Clarion, passed away peacefully on Tuesday morning, September 9, 2025 at Clarion Hospital following a period of declining health.

She was born on January 15, 1932 in Foxburg to the late Howard M. and Harriet Ruth (Sherry) Uncapher.
