Antoinette "Pix" Babington, 85, of Laurel Brook Personal Care in Brookville, formally of Crown and Clarion, passed away on Saturday January 3, 2015 at Laurel Brook. Pix enjoyed family, dancing, sporting events, and her grandchildren, and also attending her grandchildren's sporting events.
