Arnold Lee Bell, 74, of Clarion, died Thursday morning, October 14, 2010, at the Golden Living Center in Clarion.

Born September 2, 1936, in Shippenville, he was the son of Raymond Theodore and Dorothy Boyer Bell.

Mr. Bell was a graduate of the Clarion Area High School.

He was a veteran of the navy, serving from 1957 to 1961. During his time served, he was involved in anti-submarine warfare and was a photographer.

Mr. Bell worked for the Owens-Illinois Glass Plant in Bridgeton, NJ from 1965 to 1984. After the plant closed, he transferred to Owens-Illinois TV Products Division Plant. This plant was later renamed Techne-Glas, Inc. He retired from there in 1998.

He is survived by children, Daniel L. Bell of Wilkes-Barre and Linda M. Bell of Clarion.

Also surviving are three brothers, Fredrick Bell and wife, Jane, of Ohio; Raymond W. Bell and wife, Sandy, of Knox; and Robert Bell and wife, Kathy, of Clarion; two sisters, Ruth Hetrick and Lois Exley, both of Florida.
