Bernard “Bun” “Bernie” Ganoë, 79, of Clarion, passed away Wednesday evening, March 2, 2022 at the Allegheny General Hospital in Pittsburgh following a lengthy illness.

He was born on September 25, 1942 on the family farm in Clarion. Bun was the son of the late William E. and Cecelia Aaron Ganoë.

Bernie was a 1961 graduate of Clarion-Limestone High School. He then enlisted in the US Navy, proudly serving his country from 1961 to 1965.

He was a lead lineman for West Penn Power for almost 40 years until his retirement.

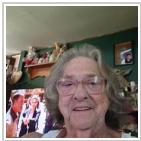

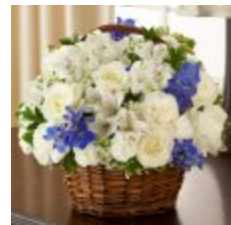
