



## Bonnie E. Cyphert

Bonnie E. Cyphert, 82, of Pine Terrace, Shippenville, passed away peacefully on Wednesday, September 21, 2022 at her home surrounded by her family. She was born on November 29, 1939 in Clarion; daughter of the late Donald C. and Marjorie L. Over Curll.

Bonnie graduated in 1957 from Clarion Area High School in which she loved to help organize class reunions with her former classmates.

Upon high school graduation, Bonnie worked for Bell Telephone, and while raising a family of four; she worked at Jamesway and Wolf Furniture. She and Dave then co-owned and operated Marianne Towers, formerly known as Rays Corner, for a few years catering and organizing many wedding and party venues. After retirement, she and Dave became co-owners of Parke Terrace Trailer Court in Clarion.

Bonnie was a talented seamstress and was well known in the community for her talent in making alterations to many bridal and prom gowns. When her children were young, she was proud to make some of their clothes, and she even made her youngest daughter's bridal party dresses; all seven of them. If she wasn't sewing, you would find her working in her flower gardens keeping them beautiful.
