Bonnie Rae Schulz, 66, a resident of Clarion Commons, Clarion, since 2000, died Friday morning, May 31, 2013, at her home.

She lived in Tionesta before moving to Clarion in 1982.

Born on January 16, 1947 in Newsmansville, Tionesta; she was the daughter of James Raymond and Hazel Jane LaVan Allio.

Bonnie was married on July 26, 1968 and divorced on May 13, 1980, to Henry David Schulz Sr., who died on January 13, 2012.

She was educated at the West Forest High School and graduated in 1965.

She then graduated in 1967 from Gail Institute in Indianapolis, IN, as a Computer Operator. After graduation, she took her first job at the Dover General Hospital in Dover, NJ.

Bonnie was a homemaker and enjoyed spending time with her children and grandchildren. She also was secretary for Clarion County Christian Academy from 1984 to 1991, along with duties of being secretary to the Pastor of the Clarion Church of the Nazarene.

She was a member of the Trinity Point Church of God since 2000. She was also a 4H club member and secretary.

Bonnie enjoyed doing family history research and has written four books. Family history was instilled in her from the age of 16 due to a tenth grade project. She did research for the Clarion Historical Society for more than 20 years.

Survived by two children, Henry David Schulz Jr. and his wife, Buffy, of East

Brady, and James Raymond Schulz and his wife, Jennifer, of Seneca; and four grandchildren.
