Carl V. Stitt, 86, of Clarion, passed away peacefully early Wednesday morning, February 12, 2025 at the Shippenville Healthcare and Rehabilitation Center.

He was born on November 21, 1938 in Clarion County; son of the late William Cecil and Ila Jane Ion Stitt.

Carl proudly served in the United States Navy during Vietnam where he was also a radioman for 11 years.

After returning home, he worked for Elslager TV in Clarion for many years before opening up his own tv repair shop in Corsica called EFCO (Electronic Furnishings Company). His slogan was "TV won't go, call EFCO". Carl then left the tv repair business and drove tractor trailer for the Drum Plant in Shippenville until he eventually retired.

He was a lifetime member of the Clarion VFW Post #2145 and Clarion American Legion Post #066 where he enjoyed going and signing the books and socializing.

Carl is survived by his daughters, Carla Taymans and her husband, Andrew, of Vermont, Valerie Stitt of Clarion, and Gretchen Hess and her significant other, Jay Fowler, of Maryland; 3 grandchildren, Katie Taymans and her husband, John Ascarino, of Massachusetts, Jackson Taymans of Vermont, and Abigail Hess of Maryland; and 2 great granddaughters, Lyra Petto and Elsie Ascarino of Massachusetts.

He is also survived by his brother, William Stitt of Butler; along with numerous

nieces and nephews.

In addition to his parents, Carl was preceded in death by his sisters, Charlotte Clarke, Mabel Cunningham, Maxine Barr, and Louise Miller and an infant brother, Earl Stitt.
