Cheryl Lynn Tack, 56, of Shippenville, passed away on Monday, February 18, 2019 at the Sugar Creek Rest Skilled Nursing Home in Worthington.

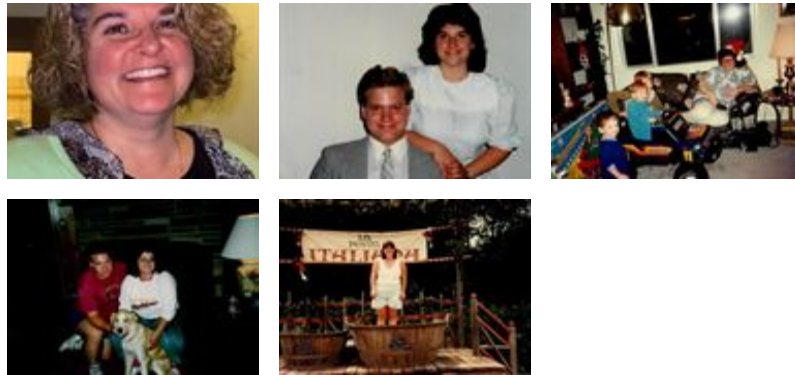

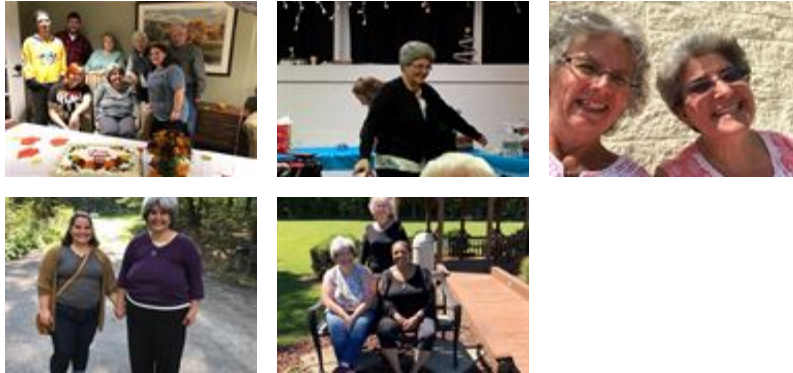
