Deloris J. Port, 81, of Clarion, died on Monday, February 9, 2015, at the McKinley Health Center in Brookville.

Born on March 1, 1933 in Flint, Michigan; she was the daughter of Franklin and Bertha Sumner Rich.

Deloris was married on September 18, 1964 to Frederick S. Port Jr., who preceded her in death on January 22, 2006.

A veteran, she served in the Navy Reserves in the W.A.C. during 1951 to 1954. During that time she earned her pilot wings.

Deloris moved to Clarion from Flint to work for A.B.C. Trailer where she worked as a secretary. She retired after 18 years of service to Clarion Township.
