Edward Jack Cyphert, 77, of Clarion, passed away Saturday, January 12, 2013, following an extended illness in the Golden Living Center in Clarion. Born April 10, 1935 in Strattanville, he was the son of Edward M. and Gwendolyn P. Sherman Klepfer Cyphert.
