Edward A. Hargenrader Jr., 52, of Rochester, MN, formerly of Clarion, died Friday, July 1, 2011, at his residence following a two year battle with cancer. Born July 29, 1958, in Clarion, he was the son of late Edward A. Hargenrader Sr. and Celestine Hartle Hargenrader of Lake Park, FL.

A veteran, he served in the Navy from 1976 to 1980 as a helicopter mechanic on the USS Enterprise.

He was married on October 5, 1985 to the former Cynthia A. Hogan, whom survives.

Mr. Hargenrader attended Clarion Area High School and Williamsport Community College.

He worked for 20 years as a master plumber for HMI Mechanical in Lyons, NY. He retired when he moved to Minnesota with his family to take care of his children.

Mr. Hargenrader was a member of the St. John the Evangelist Church in Rochester, MN.

He was also a lifelong member of the VFW.

Mr. Hargenrader frequently visited Florida to see family. He enjoyed traveling anywhere with his wife and children, particularly loved to check out amusement parks. He also enjoyed gardening and preserving what he grew, looking up recipes, and cooking.

In addition to his mother and wife, he is survived by a son, Jonathan Hargenrader and a daughter, Amy Hargenrader, both of Rochester, MN.

He was preceded in death by his father in June of 1999.
