Elizabeth H. "Betty" Mooney, 97, of Clarion passed away peacefully in her sleep after a steady decline in health on Sunday, July 10, 2016 at the Serenity House in Shippenville. She was born on June 13, 1919 in New Bethlehem; daughter of the late Carl E. and Lula McNutt Henry. Betty graduate from Clarion State College in 1941. She was married to John A.
