Florence F. Davis, 93, of Highland Oaks, Shippenville, formerly of Knox, PA, died peacefully Saturday, February 22, 2014.

Born on March 10, 1920 in Wilmington, NC; she was the daughter of the late Ferdinand and Florence D. Hawkins Fick.

She was married on August 7, 1943 to Everett Van Davis, who preceded her in death on October 16, 2007.
