Gerald R. "Jerry" Coull, 66, of Strattanville, passed away unexpectedly of natural causes early Thursday morning, July 16, 2020 at the Clarion Hospital. He was born on January 30, 1954 in Strattanville; son of the late George William Coull and Sally Ann Fike Coull, whom survives.

Jerry attended Clarion Limestone High School until he started working as a heavy equipment operator and self-employed truck driver for 20 years.

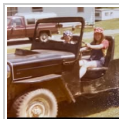

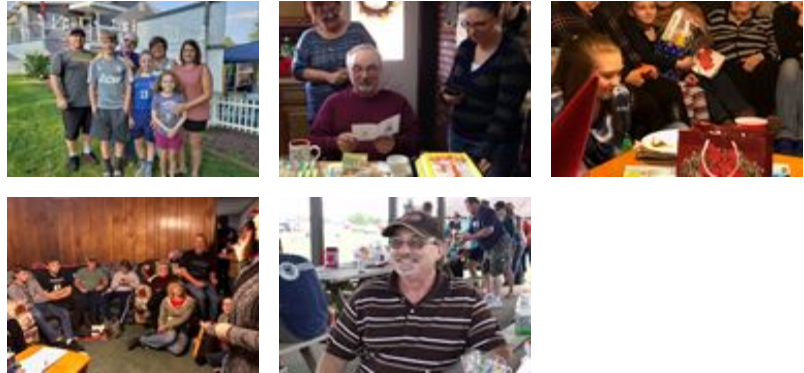
