Germaine Emma Schill, 93, of Clarion, passed away peacefully Monday evening, May 20, 2024, at home surrounded by her family.

She was born on November 3, 1930, in Marble; daughter of the late Leo X. and Nellie Weaver Strickenberger.

Germaine married Peter J. Schill on June 19, 1954. He preceded her in death on January 28, 2011.

Germaine worked at Sylvania in Brookville assembling transistors for a number of years. In 1960, she and her husband introduced pizza to Clarion when they opened Harry's Pizza Shop on Main Street. They also owned and operated Harry's Pizza Shops in Oil City, Reynoldsville and Punxsutawney. In 1973 they opened the Pizza Pub in Clarion, which remains a family business. She had a passion for the outdoors and enjoyed hiking and camping and passed that love of nature onto her children, grandchildren and great grandchildren. For many years, she maintained a large vegetable and flower garden and enjoyed canning. She was an avid reader and bird watcher and especially enjoyed spending time with her family at their camp. She was an enthusiastic card player and loved playing Euchre and Kings in the Corner. She enjoyed attending her children and grandchildren's many sporting events. Family was very important to Germaine, and she had a special place in her heart for her many nieces and nephews. She had a beautiful smile and a beautiful spirit that touched everyone who knew her.

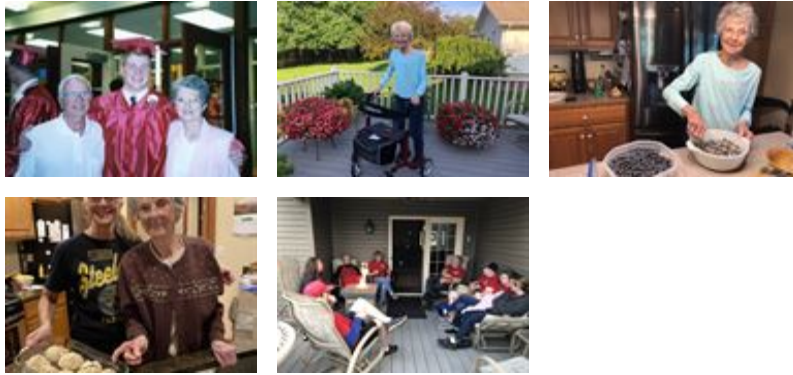
