Henry V. Schaeffer, 88, of Sligo, passed away on Tuesday, March 21, 2023 at the Baptist Health South Miami Hospital in Miami, Florida.

He was born on November 20, 1934 in Clarion; son of the late Henry L. and Ann Stark Schaeffer.

Henry married the love of his life, Nancy Stewart, on April 12, 1953, who survives.

In his earlier years, he worked at Owens Illinois Glass Plant in Clarion until his retirement. Henry also owned and operated as Captain of Prime Interest Charters on the Great Lakes for many years.
