Jean Ann Hanford-Fitzgerald, age 69, of Shippenville, died Thursday, February 27, 2014, in Shippenville.

Born December 19, 1944 in Brookville, she was the daughter of the late C.D. "Tom" and Faye McKinley Hanford.

Ms. Fitzgerald was a graduate of Clarion High School and Robert Morris College in Pittsburgh.
