Jean Lehner George, 89, of Rimersburg, passed away on Wednesday, July 31, 2019 at the Clarview Nursing and Rehabilitation Center in Sligo.

She was born on June 9, 1930 in Madison Township, Rimersburg; daughter of the late Arnold G. and Olive Murray Lehner. Jean was the last surviving member of her family.

She graduated from Union High School in 1948.

Jean married Thomas S. George on October 12, 1949, whom preceded her in death on December 29, 2016.

She delivered milk to the surrounding area from her parent's dairy farm in her early years.

Jean and her husband owned George Farms, Inc. where they pasteurized/homogenized the milk from their dairy and sold to the public.

She was a bus contractor for the Union School District for many years. Jean transported kindergarten and the Vo-tech students.

Jean is survived by her daughters: Brenda Brinker and her husband Bob of Rimersburg, Sharon Borovick and her husband Gerry of Sligo, and Sandra George and her husband Dow of California; four grandchildren; two special granddaughters: Kristen Hindman and her husband Mike and Cheryl Marshall and her husband Ross; and four special great grandchildren: Hayden, Carter, and Madison Hindman, and Emma Marshall.

She was preceded in death by her parents; husband; her sister: Ruth Mucha; and her brother: Don Lehner, who was killed in WWII.

The family will receive friends from 1 p.m. to 4 p.m. on Friday, August 2, 2019 at the Burns Funeral Home & Crematorium, Inc. in Rimersburg, where funeral services will follow in the funeral home at 4 p.m. with Peggy Mortimer, Lay Minister of the United Church of Christ in Rimersburg.
