Linda also loved visiting with the customers. She carried that love of working with the community into her later years, working at Northwest Savings Bank in Clarion, where she retired. But nothing beat the role of becoming a grandmother. Family was always at the core of what was important to Linda. She loved nothing more than being surrounded by her family, especially her grandchildren. Linda was always cheering them on in any activity they were involved in, and she very seldom missed an event. Linda took great care to make sure every holiday was special and magical for

her grandchildren. She was also dedicated to her faith and a devoted member of the Immaculate Conception Catholic Church in Clarion. Linda was a passionate Pittsburgh Steelers fan and wrote a poem for each of their Super Bowls. Linda was so honored to have one of them read by Myron Cope on live TV for Super Bowl XIV. She had a competitive side and, in her younger years, coached her daughter's softball team to a #1 finish in a local school league. Linda also loved to play softball with her extended family and was always up to challenge a play on the field with anyone. She carried her competitiveness into bowling and card games. It was never a dull moment on family game nights with Linda. She will be deeply missed by her family and those who were blessed to know her.

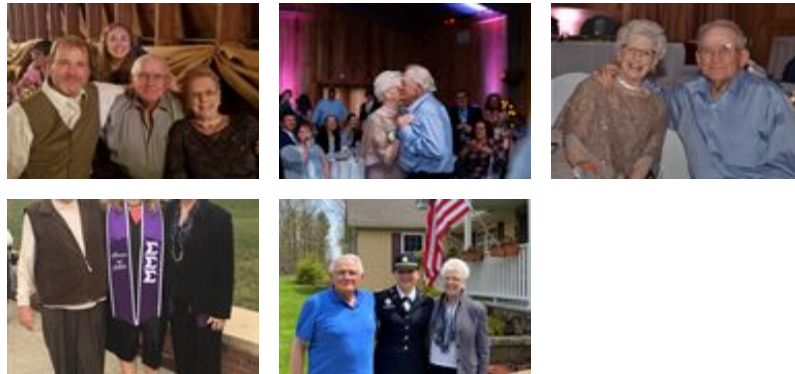
