Lloyd F. Leadbetter, 83, of Kittanning, formerly of Strattanville, died on Sunday, June 1, 2014, at the Concordia Health and Human Care in Cabot. Born on February 26, 1931 in Corsica; he was the son of John A. and Pearl M. Ambill Leadbetter.
