Lois M. McClain, 83, of Shippenville, passed away Friday, February 25, 2022 at her home from smoke inhalation due to a house fire.

Lois married Jack L. McClain in November of 1960, who preceded her in death on February 14, 2001.

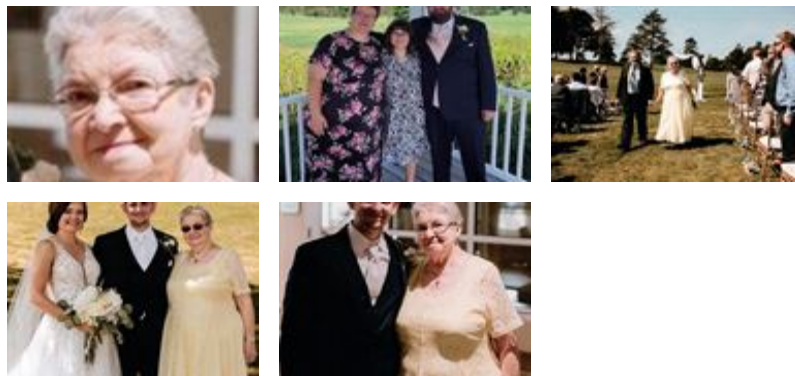
