



## Lorenzo Pierucci

December 19, 1929 - July 12, 2020

Lorenzo "Larry" Pierucci, 90, of Sligo, passed away on Sunday July 12, 2020 at his home following a brief illness.

He was born on December 19, 1929 in Sligo. The son of the late Ralph and Louise Sanesi Pierucci.

Lorenzo graduated from Clarion Area High School in 1948.

He proudly served in the 3rd Armor Division of the Army during the Korean Conflict.

Lorenzo was married on May 13, 1953 to Theresa Karg, whom survives.

He worked for the A&P Tea Company for 32 years, during that time he also worked as an independent electrician. He retired from the Clarion Hospital where he worked in the maintenance department.

Lorenzo was a lifelong member of the Immaculate Conception Catholic Church in Clarion. He was a 4th degree member of the Knights of Columbus and also a member of the Knights of St. George.

In his younger years he loved racing go-carts and spent many afternoons polishing his cars. He enjoyed Hunting and the outdoors.

Eight grandchildren and 3 great grandchildren. He is also survived by a sister, Patricia Sanesi Mudrinich and husband, Daniel of New Kensington.

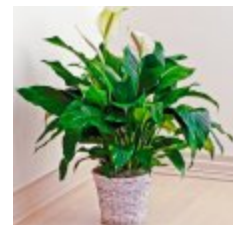
