Lowell G. Cramer, 65, of Clarion, passed away on Sunday, May 5, 2013, at the West Penn Hospital in Pittsburgh to be with his Lord and Savior after a long fought battle of cancer.

Born October 27, 1947 in Grove City; he was the son of the late Lowell T. and Vivian Bashline Cramer.

Lowell graduated from Clarion High School in 1964.

He was married on January 16, 1970 in Clarion to the former Crystal Bowser, who survives.

A veteran of the United States Army, he served in Korea and Germany for a total of three years. He was discharged in October 1973 as a Spec 4.

In previous years, Lowell had worked for Pullman Standard in Butler, Carpentertown and Canaburg Coal Companies, and Clarion Hospital in the maintenance department. He then worked at the Owen's Illinois Glass Plant in Clarion, where he retired.

He was a member of the United Mine Workers of America.

Lowell loved to hunt, seeing the Elk country, and spending time with his family, especially his three precious granddaughters.

In addition to his wife, he is survived by two sons, Aaron Cramer and his wife, Angie, of Sligo, and Brant Cramer and his wife, Kathy, of Clarion; and three granddaughters, Autumn Cramer of Sligo, and Ava and Harper Cramer of Clarion.
