



## Marcella F. Seitz

November 5, 1921 - August 24, 2025

Marcella Florence Seitz, age 103, of Lucinda, passed away peacefully early Sunday morning, August 24, 2025 at Shippenville Healthcare and Rehabilitation Center.

She was born on November 5, 1921 in Lucinda on Madden Drive on her parents', Edward B. and Kathryn S. Wolbert Ochs, farm.

On June 3, 1946, Marcella married Raymond L. Seitz, who preceded her in death on April 4, 2001. They spent 55 years together, taking many road trips to Lancaster and Florida.

Marcella was of the Catholic faith and a member of the Rosary Society at Saint Joseph Catholic Church in Lucinda.

One of her favorite enjoyments until she was 99 years old was driving with her sister, Rosemary, to get their hair curled at Yvonne the Butcher Weaver and then to the Leeper Market.
