Marian E. Hargenrader, 80, of Stoney Lonesome Road, Clarion, died early Monday, January 11, 2010, at the Clarion Hospital.

Born January 22, 1929, in Clarion, she was the daughter of Chester T. and Martha Reinsel Miller.

She was married on June 18, 1955, to Paul J. Hargenrader, who preceded her in death.

Mrs. Hargenrader attended the Immaculate Conception School and graduated from Clarion Limestone High School. She graduated from the DuBois Business College.

She was a homemaker.
