Marie I. Pasquarette Hrisak, 80, of Dave's Storage Lane, Clarion, died unexpectedly Wednesday evening, Sept. 10, 2008, at Allegheny General Hospital in Pittsburgh.

Born March 10, 1928, in Clarion County, she was the daughter of Roy and Alda Sherman Pasquarette.

Mrs. Hrisak graduated from Clarion-Limestone High School.

She worked at G.C. Murphy Company Store in Clarion for several years, before the birth of her sons. She later worked as receptionist for Dr. John Hrisak.

Mrs. Hrisak was an active member of Strattanville United Methodist Church for more than 50 years. She served in many capacities including leading the Good News Club for many years, and was also actively involved at Cherry Run Camp for over 40 years.

She was married Nov. 25, 1954, to Robert W. Hrisak, who preceded her in death in 2006.
