



## Marjorie G. Davis

September 24, 1944 - April 13, 2010

Marjorie Geraldine Davis, 65, of Strattanville, went to be with her Lord Tuesday, April 13, 2010, after a courageous battle with brain cancer at the Jefferson Manor in Brookville.

Marjorie was born on September 24, 1944, in Fisher. She was the daughter of the late Lehman W. "Chub" and Florence B. "Flossie" Summerville Davis. After graduation from Clarion Limestone High School, Marjorie went to work as a civilian for the Department of the Army on June 14, 1962 in the D.C./VA Area. She received the Superior Civilian Service Award at the time of her retirement for exceptional performance and contributions to the federal government as a civilian servant for 39 years.

Marjorie was a member of the Strattanville United Methodist Church and the Strattanville Strawberries Red Hats.

She enjoyed traveling, spending winters in FL, spending time with her many friends and relatives, playing cards and games, latch-hooking, and puzzles. Marjorie is survived by her brother, Chester B.
