



## Mary Alice Duncan

May 31, 1937 - August 28, 2014

Mary Alice Duncan, 77, of Shippenville, died on Thursday, August 28, 2014, at the UPMC Presbyterian Hospital in Pittsburgh.

Born on May 31, 1937 in Lucinda; she was the daughter of William and Martina Carroll Schupp.

Mary was a 1955 graduate of St. Joseph's Catholic School in Lucinda. She then graduated from the Spencer Nursing School in Meadville in 1958.

She was married on October 8, 1960 to Vance L. Duncan Jr., and he survives.

Mary was a registered nurse, where she had worked at Clarion Hospital, Dr. Corbett's Office, Home Health Care of Northwestern Pennsylvania, and the Clarion Area School. She also taught at the Clarion County Career Center.

Mary retired from the Golden Living Center (former Allegheny Manor).

She was a member of the St. Michael's Catholic Church in Fryburg, where she was a member of the Rosary Society and was a Eucharistic Minister. She was also a member of the Cursillo Movement Erie Diocese.

Mary was also a member of the Catholic Daughters at the Immaculate Conception Church, Fryburg Sportsman's Club, Zonta Club, Garden Club, Embroiders Guild, and former member of the Ladies Auxiliary Shippenville Elk Township Volunteer Fire Department.

She enjoyed quilting, crocheting, knitting, cross-stitching, and gardening. She also enjoyed camping, cooking and baking, and spending time with her family.

In addition to her husband, Vance, she is survived by two sons, Vance L.

Also surviving are a brother, Walter Schupp and his wife, Barbara, of East Stroudsburg; and a sister-in-law, Betty Schupp of Cleveland.

She was preceded in death by her parents and a brother, William Schupp.
