Norman E. Renninger, 74, of Strattanville, passed away unexpectedly of natural causes Saturday evening, October 12, 2024.

Norm was a 1968 graduate of Clarion Limestone High School.

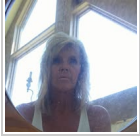

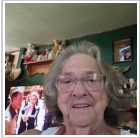
