Rebecca E. Bowser, 82, of East Brady, passed away on Monday, July 29, 2024 at Butler Memorial Hospital.

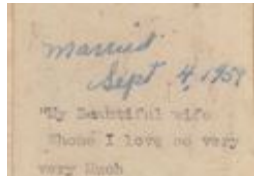
