



## Robert P. Jordan

September 22, 1953 - April 24, 2013

Robert Paul Jordan, 59, of Tionesta, formerly of East Brady and New Bethlehem, peacefully passed away at his home on April 24, 2013, following an extended illness.

Born September 22, 1953 in Butler, PA, he was the son of Walter George and Laura Jane Ferguson Jordan of East Brady.

He was a 1972 graduate of East Brady High School.

After graduation, "Bob" enlisted in the United States Navy at the storekeeper rank. His tenured service from September 1972 to October 1992 included time at: RTC Orlando, FL, SKA San Diego, CA, Commissioned USS William Pratt Charleston, SC, NAS Willow Grove Willow Grove, PA, Naval Station Adak, AK, NAVCRUDIST Columbus, OH, Fletracen NSC Norfolk, VA, Commissioned USS Sphinx ARL 24 Little Creek, VA, NAS Keflavik, Iceland, Naval Station, Mayport, FL, and NAS Bermuda.
