Roland Lloyd “Rollie” Wolf, age 70, of Medina, Ohio, formerly of Clarion, passed away on Friday, September 5, 2025, with his family by his side after a year-long battle with brain cancer.

He was born on December 29, 1954, in Cleveland, Ohio to the late George and Carolyn Schieberl Wolf.

Rollie graduated from Clarion Area High School in 1973. He attended Triangle Tech in Dubois and graduated in 1997, earning an Associates Degree in Specialized Technology.

Rollie worked at the KOA Wolf Campground, later, moving on to asphalt, truck driving, and then being a machine operator in factories. He took pride in his work to provide for his family.

Rollie married the former Cindy Swigart on May 12, 1984, who preceded him in death.

He also looked forward to the summers when his granddaughters would stay with him to swim, take walks to the stores and order pizza for movie nights.

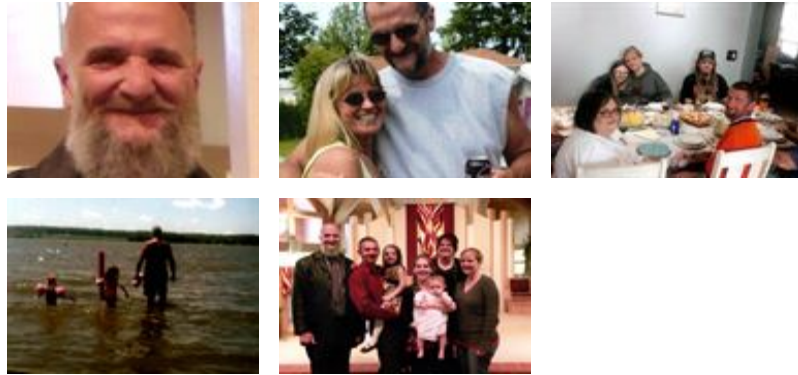
