Roxanne L. Davis, age 60, of Strattanville, passed away peacefully early Tuesday morning, February 10, 2026, at McKinley Health Center in Brookville following a lengthy illness.

Roxanne graduated from Clarion-Limestone High School in 1983. Following graduation, she obtained her cosmetology certificate from Dubois Cosmetology School.

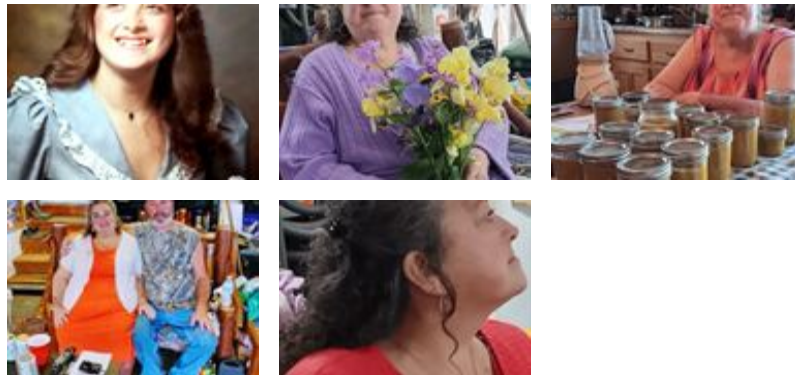
