Terry W. Aites, 58, of Lucinda, passed away on Tuesday, November 24, 2020 at the UPMC Presbyterian Hospital in Pittsburgh following a courageous battle with Covid-19.

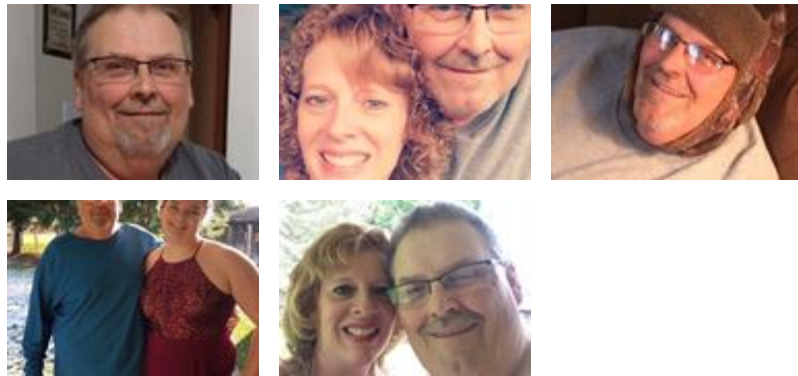

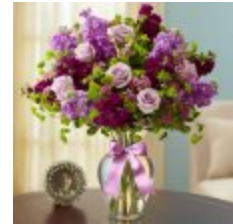

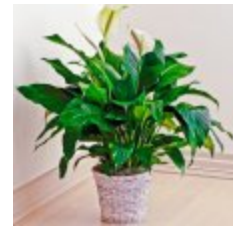
