Timothy J. "Tim" Hockman, 57, of Miola, passed away peacefully on Saturday, October 23, 2021 at his home.

Tim graduated from Keystone High School in 1982.

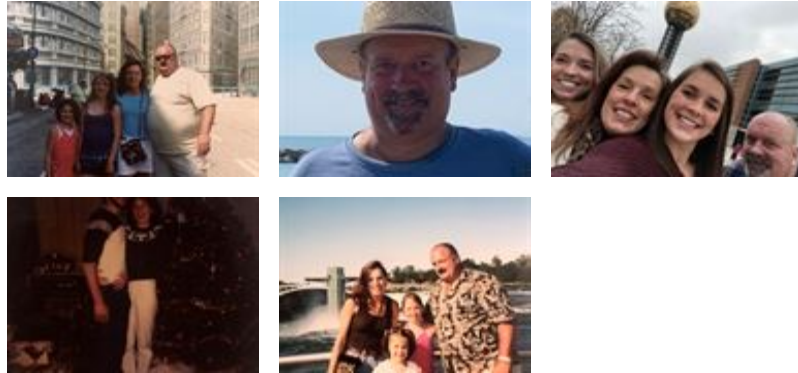
