



## Todd L. Curll

October 11, 1920 - June 13, 2016

Todd L. Curll, 95, of Curllsville, passed away unexpectedly after a fall at his home at 6:30 a.m. on Monday, June 13, 2013 at the U.P.M.C. Presbyterian Hospital in Pittsburgh.

He was the last surviving member of his immediate family.

Todd was born on October 11, 1920 in Curllsville in the original family farmhouse that was built in 1832. There were six generations raised there, Todd being the fifth and his children being the sixth and last generation raised on the farm.

He was the son of the late C. V. and Maude McCurdy Curll.

Todd was married on June 30, 1944 to Arlie McDowell, who preceded him in death on September 25, 2004.

He was a farmer all of his life and took over the family farm and dairy business when he got married and his father retired.

Todd closed the dairy business in 1962.

He was known for his penmanship and enjoyed writing letters to the Editor and he was also known for his opinions on politics.

Todd was known for his ability to fix things and people would often say "take it over to Todd and he will fix it".

Like his two daughters, Todd had a tremendous love for animals.

He and his wife loved to travel.

In his younger years he played the Clarinet in the Sligo band.

Todd attended the Grace Community Church in Curllsville.

He is survived by a son, William Curll and his wife Mary of Columbiana, OH, a daughter, Kathy Curll- Hoenig and her husband Russ of Kingsville, a granddaughter, Lisa Curll-Rapp and her husband Trevor of Cleveland, OH, his beloved Cat, Benny "Batman", and a very special friend Ruby Myers, whom the family would like to thank for all of her help, generosity, and love. She is God's gift to this earth.

Todd was preceded in death by his parents, wife, a daughter, Marilyn, his brothers, Vanlier, D. R., Dean, and an infant brother, James.
