



## Walter W. Bauer

August 10, 1938 - December 3, 2017

Walter W. "Wally" Bauer, 79, of Lucinda, passed away peacefully on Sunday, December 3, 2017 at home surrounded by his family, following a lengthy bout with Cancer.

He was born on August 10, 1938 in Lucinda; son of the late Maurice and Catherine Wolbert Bauer.

After graduating from North Clarion High School in 1956, he then went to Barber School in Erie.

He was a Veteran of the US Army.

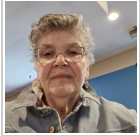
